## **MANUAL OSTEOPATHY — CCC Osteopathy**

It is a non-invasive, manual form of medicine that focuses on the inter-relationships of the structure and function of all the body systems. It aims to restore health to the body by removing restrictions within the musculoskeletal system to improve nerve, blood and lymphatic flow.
