However, during the “Age of Reason” astronomy was no longer considered theoretical, but an actual field of study.

What led to the separation of astronomy and astrology was the change in the philosophical basis of scientific knowledge in the seventeenth century. Astrology took its legitimation from the Greek philosophical theory, also accepted by Aristotle, ‘as above so below’. This says that which occurs in the heavens is mirrored here on earth.
