The basic principles of color, form, texture, balance, contrast, continuity, etc. all apply to electronically delivered media, too. Navigational design determines how users get around. Using a relatively flat structure makes key information accessible from a single interface.

The Redundancy Principle. "People learn better from graphics and narration than some graphics, narration, and printed text." (p. 118) Many multimedia presentations involve a combination of spoken words, graphics, and on-screen text.

Principles of Multimedia Learning - Center for Teaching ...

Multimedia principle ... or people learn better from words and pictures than from words alone. In any kind of training, it is customary to use words, either printed or spoken, as the main method of sharing information. Words are quick and cheap - an instructional designer doesn't need specialist software or expertise to produce them.

Mayer's principles for multimedia ... - instructional design

Symmetrical balance weights the elements evenly on either sides of the design, while asymmetrical uses contrast to even out the flow of design (i.e. dark elements are balanced out by light ones). Need more design inspiration ?

Multimedia Interface Design

It tightens the design and eliminates the haphazard, messy effect which comes when items are placed randomly.
