The primary basis for Cameroonian citizenship is through descent or *ius sanguinis*. A child will be deemed to be a citizen of Cameroon by birth if he/she is born in Cameroon, yet to unknown parents. While there is no legal provision which addresses the issue of dual citizenship, Article 31 of the Cameroonian Nationality Code of 1968 mentions instances where a Cameroonian nationality can be lost.
