CUA-CUOG guidelines for the management of castration ...

Chemotherapy may be used to treat castrate-resistant prostate cancer that is causing symptoms. The chemotherapy drugs most commonly used are docetaxel (Taxotere) with prednisone. But if docetaxel and prednisone are no longer working, you may be given cabazitaxel (Jevtana) or mitoxantrone.

Advanced prostate cancer includes a wide spectrum of disease ranging from hormone naïve or hormone sensitive to castration resistant, both containing populations of men who have demonstrable metastatic and non-metastatic states. The mainstay of treatment for metastatic hormone-sensitive prostate cancer is androgen deprivation therapy (ADT).
