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### Star Spangled Banner Activity

Making the Star-Spangled Banner. On September 14, 1814, U.S. soldiers at Baltimore's Fort McHenry raised a huge American flag to celebrate an important victory over British forces during the War of 1812. The sight of those "broad stripes and bright stars" inspired Francis Scott Key to write a song that eventually became the United States national anthem.

### OurStory : Activities : Making the Star-Spangled Banner
